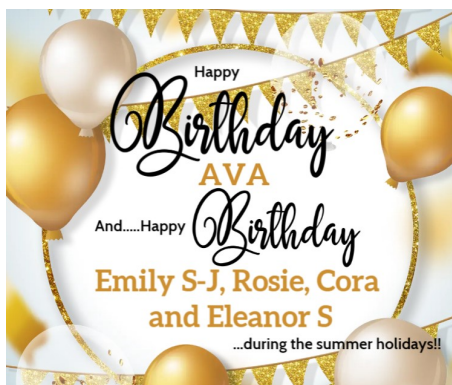

If you need help before you have back from or contact your GP instead. We do not have a helpline or 111. Our text number does not receive voice calls or SMS picture messages. We support messaging from UK mobile numbers only (texts do not include messages sent from landlines, international mobile numbers and some number matching mobile apps). To prevent the health professional from sending messages to you, text STOP to our number. Messages are not sent at your expense.
