Welcome to our autumn season of events in the Learning Centre and at The Base. These workshops, courses and activities are at the heart of what we do and, over the past few months, we have continued to engage with people of all ages, both in our local community and indeed from across the country, through our digital programme of activity. We know that some people will not be able to join us in person just yet so some of our courses are now being delivered completely online, and for other courses you will have the choice of whether you take part online or in person.

During the lockdown period, our **Youth Theatre** moved online and they will continue this autumn with a combination of online and in person sessions to enable our young people to keep up their weekly drama activity.

The Gallery at The Base also reopens in September with a wonderful celebration of the longstanding literary partnership of **Quentin Blake and John Yeoman**. These instantly recognisable illustrations will evoke memories of favourite childhood stories and we also look forward to introducing this beautiful artwork to a new generation.

Whichever activity you choose to try, and whether it is online or in person, I and all the team here look forward to welcoming you back.

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Ruentin Blake and John Yeoman 50 Years of Children's Books



The Base reopens this autumn with House of Illustration's 50 Years of Children's Books exhibition, which celebrates the work of Quentin Blake and John Yeoman.

Much-loved illustrator Quentin Blake has had a number of extended collaborations with writers, but the longest of all has been with John Yeoman. House of Illustration's 50 Years of Children's Books is the first to celebrate this partnership. It features the original drawings from their first book, A Drink of Water, and ten other projects by the pair – from picture books and short novels for children to adaptations of classic folk tales, including The Boy Who Sprouted Antlers, The Fabulous Foskett Family Circus and Up with Birds.


